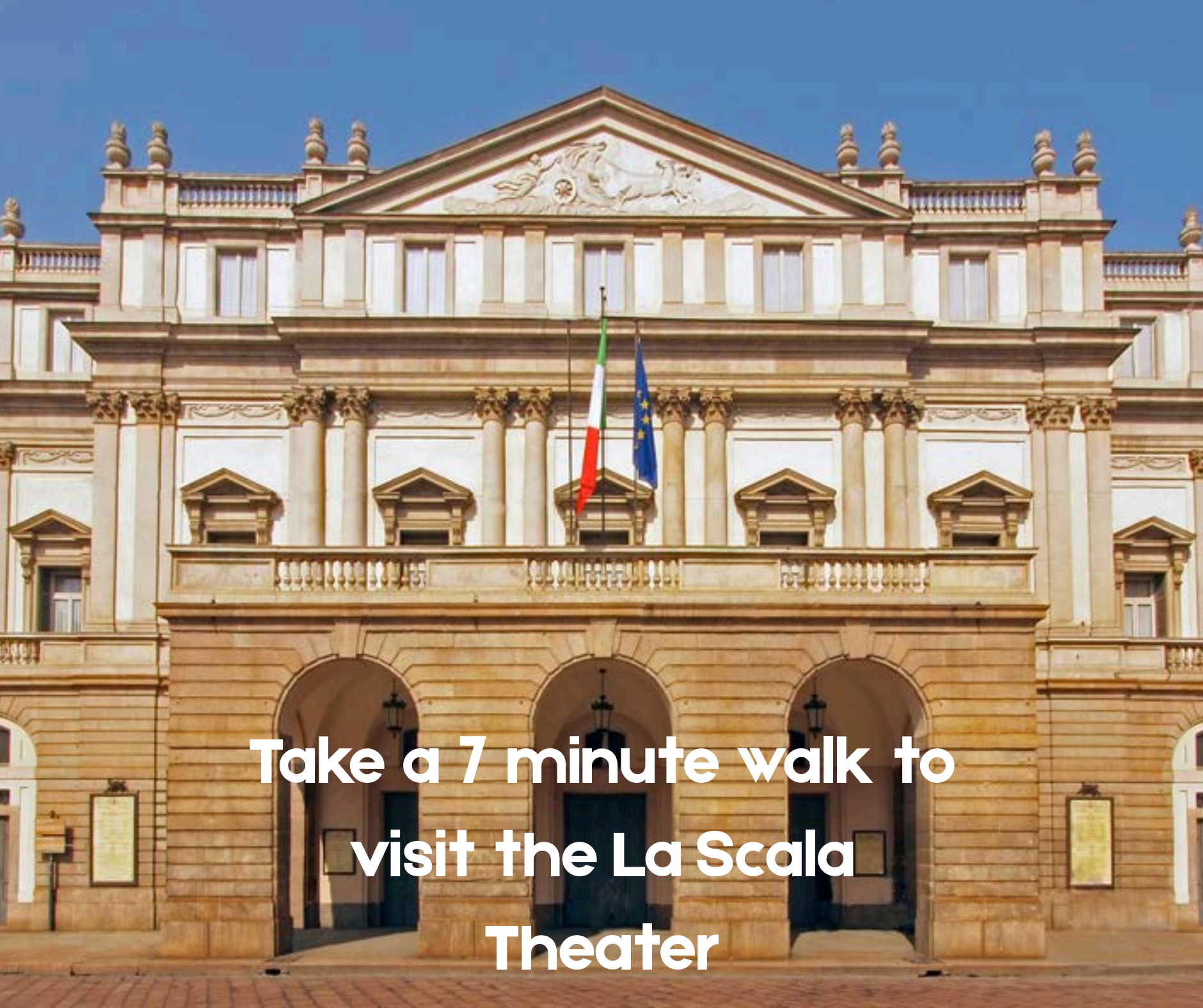

Milan.**






**Take a quick coffee

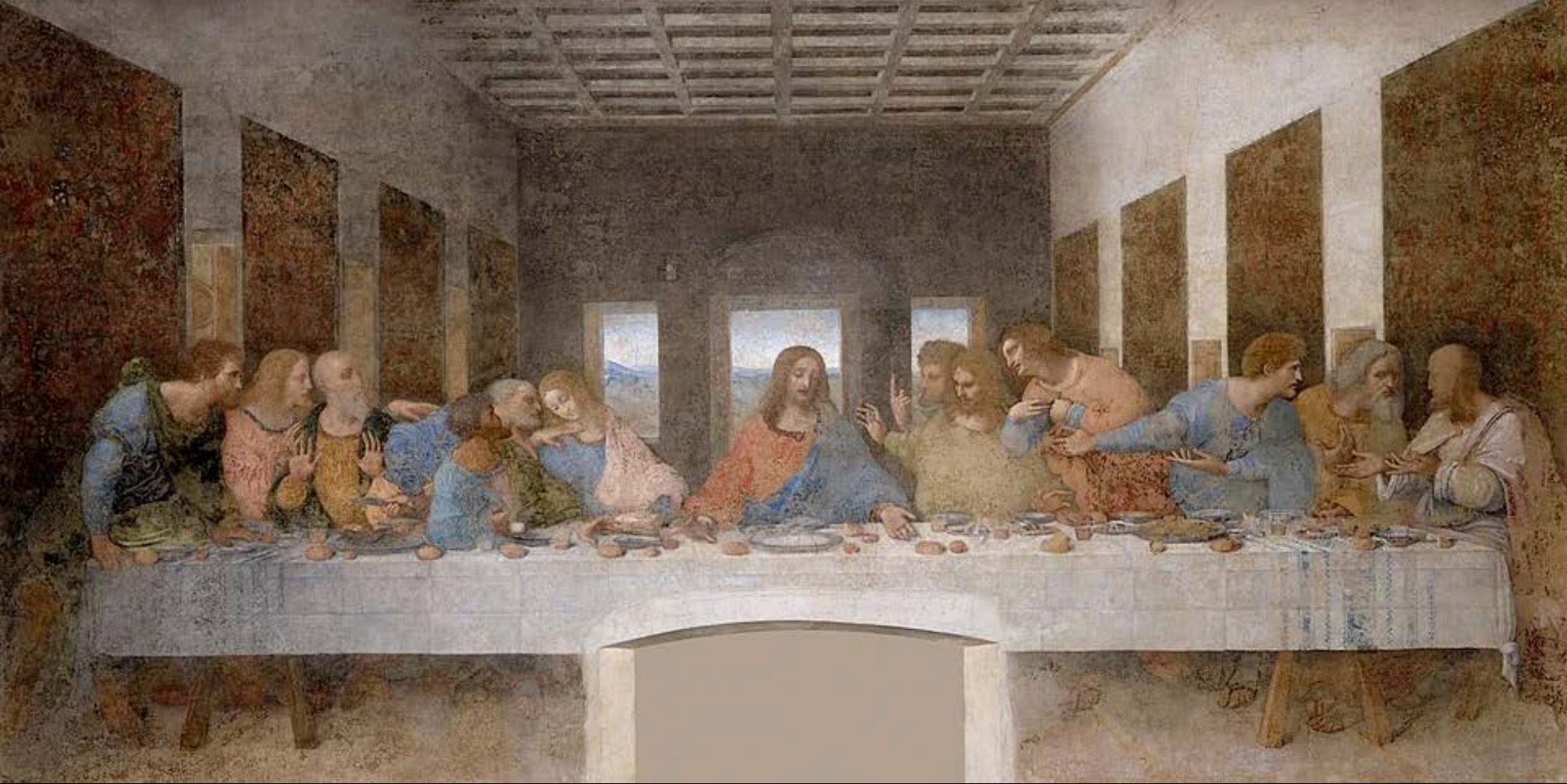
**AFTERNOON**

**Take the short walk to the Brera District, which is a historic, elegant and arty neighbourhood East of Sforza Castle.**



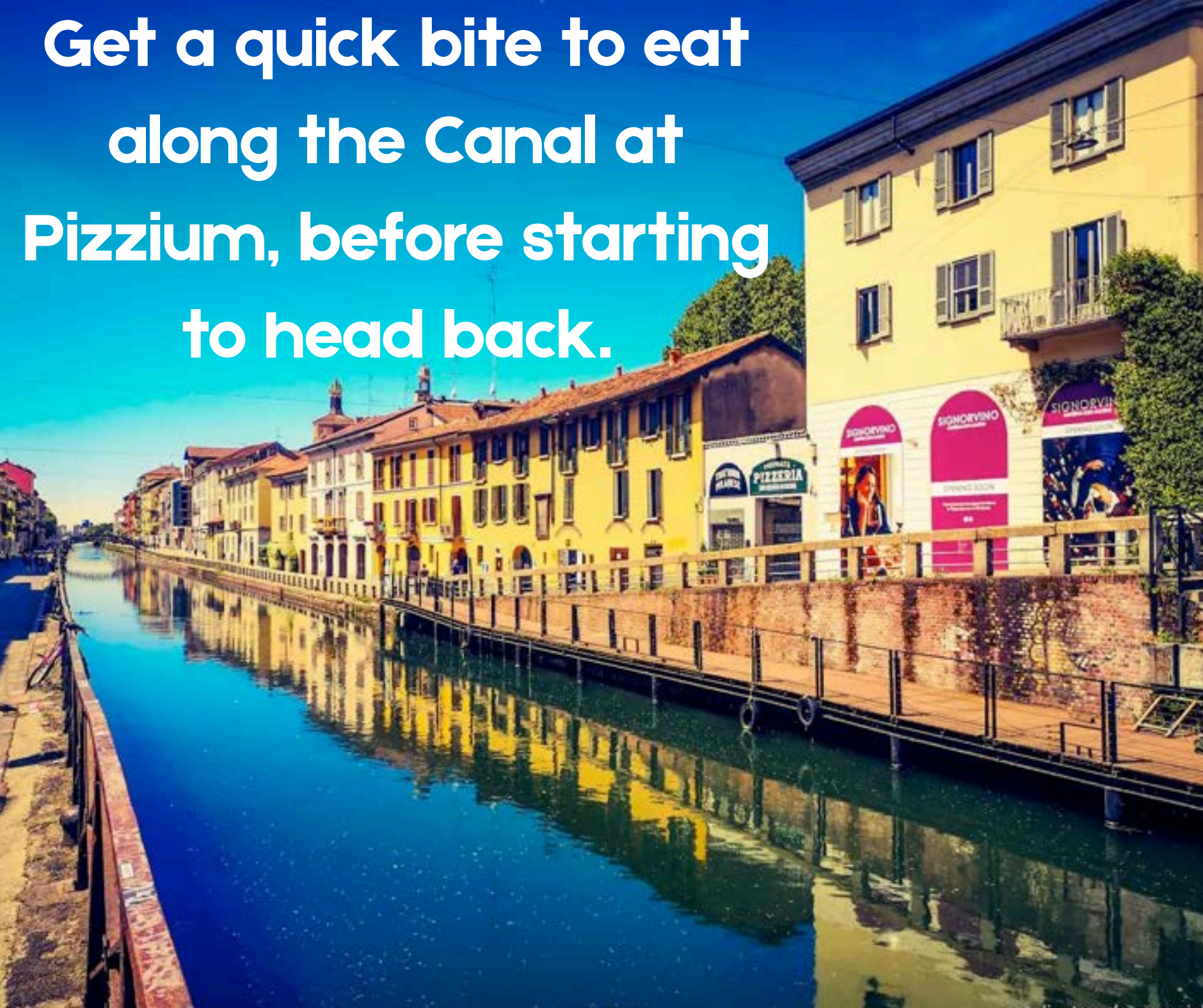


**If pre-booked for ~12-13, visit the Last Supper in Santa Maria delle Grazie. If not, head straight to the Navigli Canals.**

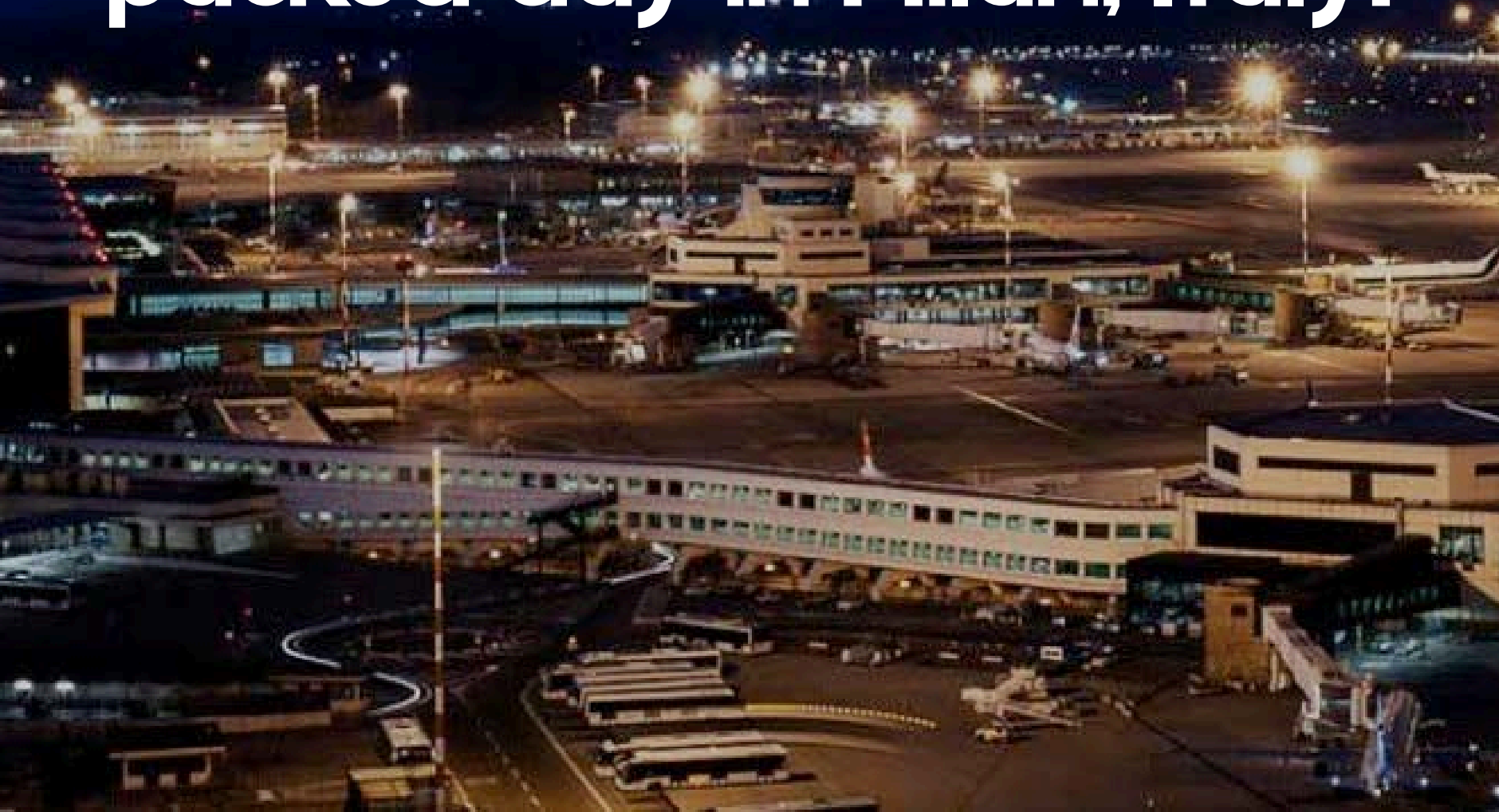
